



- Prepares you for a career in financial services
 - What do the different roles do in finance (e.g. investment banker, salesperson, sell-side trader, hedge fund analyst, buy-side trader)?
 - How do you write a resume/cover letter?
 - How can you land a summer internship?
- Pairs you with an **upperclassman**mentor who can help you through the recruiting process

- Emphasizes small group work with members of the career development team to provide more individualized recruiting guidance and stock pitch preparation
- Helps you decide on a specific sector (TIBC, TTC, Alpha Fund) based on your career interests



- First Meeting Date: September 25th from 8-9 pm in Braker 001




Applications close Monday, September 15

The Alpha Fund is a concentrated, long-only global equities portfolio of ~\$450k managed by ~20 students

- Conduct equity research to pitch new positions, manage existing positions, and discuss recent market developments
- For students who have learned the basics of financial modeling and valuation and are interested in public markets investing. Students may apply by presenting a value-oriented stock pitch demonstrating knowledge of valuation and business models

Outperformed benchmark by over **700bps**

- Involvement in the diversity accelerator program is a great way to navigate the accelerated diversity recruitment and secure a job in finance early



Typical Club Progression

First-Year

First Semester:

Learn the different jobs within the finance industry through the CDC. Learn the fundamentals of valuation through TIBC's crash course

Second Semester:

If you haven't already, join a sector (TTC, TIBC, Alpha Fund, etc.). Begin networking.

Sophomore

Networking, Applying, & Interview Prep: for both Sophmore & Junior Summer Internships:

For banking, this is the most important year!

Make connections with alumni and apply to junior summer internships in the fall/winter/spring.

Junior

Keep Recruiting:

Lock down a junior summer internship.

Senior

If you did NOT receive a return offer:

Continue to network and leverage Tufts and other connections.

Apply for any open positions as soon as possible (full-time applications go out on a rolling basis).

If you received a return offer:

Consider mentoring lower-classmen.




