Tufts Alpha Fund

The Alpha Fund is a concentrated, long-only global equities portfolio of ~\$310k managed by ~15 students

- Conduct equity research to pitch new positions, manage existing positions, and discuss recent market developments
- For students who have learned the basics of financial modeling and valuation and are interested in public markets investing. Students may apply by presenting a value-oriented stock pitch demonstrating knowledge of valuation and business models
- 4-5 hours per week (meetings at 9pm on Sundays and one pitch per semester from each member)


Diversity Accelerator Program


Students in the TFG mentorship program are assigned an upperclassman mentor to guide you and get to know you on a more personal level

Second Semester: If


you haven't already, join a sector (TTC, TIBC, Alpha Fund, etc.). Begin networking.
